

Steelhead Bait Rigging

What: How to Rig for Steelhead (and Salmon) River Fishing

When the rains hit, the rivers flow and the steelhead and salmon begin running on the western rivers, you need to know how to get the attention of the fish. Here are a few ways which will cover most of your needs.

One Simple Setup: The EGG LOOP RIG






- 1 - Start with about 42" leader.
- 2 - Make 20 tight wraps on the hook shank.
- 3 - Run end of leader through hook eye.
- 4 - Continue with 5 more wraps.
- 5 - Pull out slack.
- 6 - You now have a leader with a loop to hold your roe.

Three Useful Rigs:

Drift Fishing Setup: usually used from a boat. Switch weight to maintain contact with the river bottom.

Stream Rig: typically used from shore. Can be modified with corkie/spin-n-glo near bait.

Side Drift/Bobber Setup can be helpful for detecting light strikes or fishing technical waters.
